## **HK GOVERNMENT THANKS IFACT-GC FOR MOVIE DVDS**

### ***120 Latest Blockbusters on DVD Donated to Quarantine Centres***

Hong Kong – On May 21, Mr. Sam Ho, Executive Director and General Manager of the International Federation Against Copyright Theft-Greater China (IFACT-GC) presented 120 DVDs to the Leisure and Cultural Services Department, the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region.

The DVDs, featuring the latest blockbuster movies from Motion Picture Association member companies, will be distributed to Hong Kong quarantine centres to provide entertainment to people undergoing quarantine.

“We hope that the discs will be watched by as few people as possible but that they help make quarantine as pleasant as it can possibly be for anyone who undergoes quarantine,” said Mr. Ho.”
